Introduction of the sleeper production plant of Azerinsaatservis LLC.

On August 23, President of the Republic of Azerbaijan İlham Aliyev attended to the sleeper production plant of Azerinsaatservis LCC located in Alat, Garadağ.

The leader of our state was informed that one of the basic materials used in the construction and repair of railways was pre-stressed concrete sleeper. The demand of our country for this material had been fulfilled by importation, leading to loss of time and incremental cost. Today, the need of the Republic for sleepers is satisfied by this production plant. Execution of the Baku -Ahalkalaki- Kars Railway Project has considerably increased the importance of the production plant in question.

The construction of the sleeper production plant started in 2005 and completed at the end of the previous year. Having a total value of 4,2 million Manats, it is the only production plant meeting the modern standards of the countries in the Caucasus and the Caspian Sea Region. All equipment of the production plant was imported from the German company Walter Beton GMBH. Production is carried out in compliance with the Vaslov system, a widely used system in developing countries. The production plant bears a production capacity of 240.000 ton sleepers / year. Meaning the construction of 75 - 80 km of new railway lines annually.

Upon the completion of construction, installation and erection, 2 thousand sleepers were manufactured in the production plant for trial purposes. Tests performed by European laboratories on the product samples, gave good results.

Today, this production plant provides 72 people with employment. Given the workers who shall be employed in the construction of the new railway, it will employ more than 1000 people in general. For the most part, domestic raw materials are used in production. However, the material having a special tensile strength and creating elasticity in sleepers imported from Italy.

As a result of this, President of the Republic of Azerbaijan İlham Aliyev gave the necessary recommendations to increase the capacity.
