## **The President of the Republic of Azerbaijan takes a close interest in the construction of Baku Ring Road**

### **Baku Ring Road is planned to be open on August 2010**



Today, President of the Republic of Azerbaijan Ilham Aliyev has taken a close interest in the construction of Baku Ring Road. The President of the Republic has been informed that the main road is 21,5 km long and the side road is 11,65 km together with Bileceri Downgrade. The width of the 6-lane road's soil bed will be 33,5 meters and the width of the main road will be 22,5 meters. Each lanes will have a width of

3,75 meters. Asphalt coating of the road will be 19-27 cm thick.

60% of the earth works, 11% of the asphalt works, 90% of the drainage pipe laying works and 80% of the communication line transportation works have been completed.

Besides, the leader has been informed about the technical and economic indicators of the road's retaining walls. It has been stated that the construction of a 22.359 m<sup>2</sup> earth retaining wall is planned so that any landslide and cracks can be detected and prevented during the construction.

Afterwards, President of the Republic of Azerbaijan Ilham Aliyev has arrived at the section of Baku Ring Road which will link to the main road at the border of Baku-Iran. The President of the Republic has been informed that, within the framework of the project, it is planned that 6 bridges, 1 underpass, 1 subway and 4 bus stops will be constructed. Up to the present, 80% of the bridges and 96% of the underpasses and subways have been constructed.

In total, 63% of the works has been completed and Baku Ring Road is predicted to be put into service on August 2010. /Azertac/
