US Ambassador Visiting Ongoing Rehab Works of the Strategic Samtskhe-Javakheti Road.



On May 6, US Ambassador to Georgia John Bass and MCG CEO George Abdushelishvili, together with the representatives from Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) and construction companies paid a visit at Azerinsaatservis Construction Camp Headquarters in Akhalkalaki.

Azerinsaatservis is one of four construction companies selected by MCG through the international competitive bidding. According to \$50 million contract, company carries out rehabilitation works on the Teleti-Koda-Asureti (19km) and the Nardevani-Satkhe (47,8km) road sections. The road construction-rehabilitation works is also performed by: Ashrom International Ltd (Israel), the joint venture Papenburg/Black Sea Group (Germany-Georgia), and Akkord Insaat Senaye (Azerbaijan).

The works are carried out within the framework of MCG's Samtskhe-Javakheti Road Rehabilitation Project and envisage rehabilitation of around 223 km road in Kvemo Kartli and Samtskhe-Javakheti regions.

Construction works are intensively conducted on all sections of the road: weak sections of the ground are reinforced, ground is leveled and the frost-resistant layer is applied. The first layer of asphalt is already being laid in some parts of the road. Currently, winter maintenance and preservation works are underway on all sections of the Samtskhe-Javakheti Road.
