The construction in the Georgian section of Baku-Tbilis-Gars railway is extending speedily

The Limited Liability Company “Azerinshaatservis“ extends the constructions works speedily on the “reconstruction project of railway at the border of Akhalkalaki-Kartsakhi-Turkey” within the framework of the project of Baku-Tbilisi-Gars (BTG) railway.

The delegation headed by Mr. Ziya Mammadov, the minister of Transport of Azerbaijan Republic visited Georgia in order to be acquainted on-site with the construction works. Besides the ministers, the above-mentioned delegation was composed of mr. Javid Gurbanov, the chairman of the Open Joint-Stock Company “Azeryolservis”, Mr. Arif Asgarov, the chairman of the Close Joint-Stock Company “Azerbaijan Railways” and Mr. Vusal Aslanov, the Borad member of “Azerinshaatservis” MMC, the deputy director. Besides the delegation from Azerbaijan, B.Bregadze, the head of the railway administration of Marabda-Tetriskaro, Georgia and his deputy were amongst the persons who have visisted the site. The minister of transport visited the site in 27 and 31-th of August, meeting with the representatives of “Azerinshaatservis” LLC carrying out their activity in Georgia has taken an interest in the course of works and provided them with some consultations and recommendations. At the end, the minister has provided them with tasks related to fulfillment of construction works with high quality.

Despite temporary delays because of some technical problems arisen by the severe weather condition and unsatisfactory study of the geological structure of the road while drawing up of the initial draft, the works in the line of finishing this project are extending speedily.

The total length of the railway to be constructed as per the project at the border of Akhalkalaki-Kartsakhi-Turkey” is 25.65 km. At the same time, the project stipulates construction of 5 stations, 6 bridges and 5 road junctions.

The project envisages to finish the construction works mainly in 2011 and to bring into operation of BTG railway in 2012. Within the initial period of operation we suggest to carry through this line 1 million passengers and 6,5 million tons of freight in a year and in 2034 – 3 million passengers and 17 million tons of freight.
